

What YOU Can Do To Help Capture Palestinian Arab Murderers of Americans

More than 90 American citizens have been murdered by Palestinian Arab terrorists since 1968--and 29 of them have been murdered since the signing of the Oslo accords in September 1993. Here are some practical steps you can take to help bring the killers to justice or to assist the victims' families:

1. Urge U.S. Government Action to Capture the Killers

The Koby Mandell Act, which was recently introduced in both the Senate (where it is known as S.1377) and in the House of Representatives (where it is known as H.R. 2098) would establish a special office within the Department of Justice to focus on capturing Palestinian Arab terrorists who have harmed American citizens, and assisting the victims and their families.

Urge your Senators and Representatives to become co-sponsors of the Koby Mandell Act. Call the Congressional switchboard, 202-224-3121, and ask to be connected to the office of your choice.

[The co-sponsors so far are Senators Gordon Smith (R-OR), Rick Santorum (R-PA), and Sam Brownback (R-KS); and Representatives Rob Andrews (D-NJ), Jim Saxton (R-NJ), Jerrold Nadler (D-NY), Steven LaTourette (R-OH), Steven Rothman (D-NJ), Connie Morella (R-MD), Anthony Weiner (D-NY), Eliot Engel (D-NY), Ken Bentsen (D-TX), Eric Cantor (R-VA), Joseph Hoeffel (D-PA) & Chris Smith (R-NJ).]

2. Indict the Murderers

The Israeli government has publicly identified more than 20 Palestinian Arab terrorists who were involved in attacks in which Americans were murdered. They are being sheltered by the Palestinian Authority. In order to bring them to America for trial, the U.S. government must indict them. Yet not one such indictment has ever been issued.

3. Fire Murderers of Americans From Arafat's Security Forces

The Israeli government has publicly identified four suspected murderers of Americans who are serving in the Palestinian Authority security forces: Bassam Issa, Kamal Khalifa, Yasser Khasin, and Mahmad Sanwar.

4. Don't Let Terrorists Profit From Their Crimes

Veteran PLO leader Abu Daoud (Mohammed Oudeh) has written an autobiography in which he admits masterminding the 1972 Munich Olympics massacre, in which 12 people, including David Berger of Ohio, were murdered. The book was published in France and now a U.S. publisher plans English-language edition.

The profits from the book sales will go into Daoud's pocket--a killer of an American will profit from his crime.
