

## **OLMERT'S PLAN FOR THE GOLAN** **SYRIAN REPORTS OLMERT WILLING TO CEDE ENTIRE GOLAN!**

When Syria controlled the Golan, between 1948 and 1967, it systematically shelled and attacked the Israeli towns below, killing 140 Israelis and injuring many more.

Syrian media are reporting that Prime Minister Ehud Olmert has informed Syrian dictator Bashar Assad that he is willing to give up the entire Golan Heights. Olmert allegedly made the offer via Turkish Prime Minister Recep Tayyip Erdogan.

Israel liberated the Golan Heights in the 1967 Six Day War, thus freeing northern Israel of the Syrian threat. Israel soon realized that the Golan was vital not only militarily, but also in terms of water, history, and more. The Golan was officially annexed to Israel in 1981, and over the years, 33 Jewish communities were built, including the full-fledged town of Katzrin. Today, close to 17,000 Jewish residents in 33 communities (27 kibbutzim and moshavim, five communal settlements and the town of Katzrin) live on the Golan Heights and the slopes of Mt. Hermon. In addition, 19,000 Druze and 2,000 Muslims live there as well.

Opposition MKs say Olmert is negligently forsaking Israeli security merely so he can survive politically:

- Likud Party elements were quoted as saying. "There is no limit to the dangerous concessions that Olmert is willing to make simply so that he can remain in office,"
- MK Brig.-Gen. (ret.) Effie Eitam (National Union), a former IDF Galilee Formation commander and a resident of the Golan Heights town of Nov, said simply, "Olmert is abandoning Israel's security."
- MK David Tal, of Olmert's own Kadima party, said Israel's departure from the Golan would lead to the entry of Hizbullah terrorists into the area. Tal said he plans to advance legislation that would require a referendum on any Golan giveaway.
- MK Yuval Shteinitz (Likud) said, "This is an unprecedented security blunder... Without the Golan, Israel will have difficulty defending its existence or maintaining the Kinneret Sea and the water sources there."

Is there a solution for the military crisis plaguing Israel's south? Can Israel successfully deal with the Kassam rockets? Or, is Prime Minister Ehud Olmert right when he tells us that we just have to get used to it?

You don't need to be a military expert to come up with a plan to solve the Gaza problem. Israel already has a successful model that works perfectly — at least since the Yom Kippur War. It is the real peace model that has been implemented for years in the Golan Heights.

in Israel is? Where you don't have to worry about Arabs throwing rocks at your car? Where you can walk around at night without fear of arms or drug smugglers crossing the border? That place is the Golan Heights. Without even trying, possibly even by mistake, Israel enjoys real peace there. Any new peace plan must follow the principles that have brought us true peace in the Golan.

There are just five easy steps:

1. Encourage Arab emigration
2. Conquest
3. Israeli sovereignty
4. Settlement
5. No peace accords

Sixty thousand Syrian Arabs who were scattered throughout villages in the Golan Heights disappeared even before the Golan was liberated. The only ones who stayed were the Druze in the Golan's north. These villages are the exception that proves the necessity of implementing the first principle. *(Because they are a source of constant problems - frequently declaring their allegiance to Syria - perhaps anticipating Israel has not the internal fortitude to sustain its control of the territory? – Jsk)*



The second principle, conquest, was fully implemented by Israel in the Golan. No foreign forces remained there. The area is entirely controlled by Israel.

Israel declared sovereignty over the entire Golan, settled it and, most important, never signed a peace treaty with Syria. This is how we have prevented the war, under the guise of peace, that we suffer on our border with Egypt from repeating itself on our border with Syria. These five steps will bring peace and security to Gaza, Judea and Samaria.

How do we encourage the Arabs in these places to emigrate without the necessity of a major war? Al Najah University in Shechem answered that question with their poll results. It turns out that over 60 percent of the Arabs in Judea and Samaria do not need any encouragement to leave. They are disgusted with the rule of the armed thugs that the Oslo Peace Club forced upon them. Their preferred destinations are the Gulf States and Canada.

Many Western states currently suffer from negative demographics — less than two children per family. They are anxious to absorb skilled immigrants like the Arabs of Judea and Samaria who have learned quite a lot from Israel over the past 60 years. The huge current

of Muslim immigrants that has engulfed the Western world over the past few decades points to the fact that this solution is entirely possible.

Israel must make available to the Arabs all the resources necessary to encourage this trend. Approximately 10 percent of Israel's entire budget is wasted annually on impossible solutions based on the Oslo eagerness to partition the Land of Israel. This sum constantly grows, as megacostly solutions like the separation fence

are proven absurd. They are then exchanged for even more grandiose defensive schemes such as cutting edge space technology to protect Israel's citizens from flying missiles. The colossal sums of money spent on these unrealistic programs could be spent more effectively. Instead of paying for more white elephants, Israel can give \$250,000 to every Arab family that will stake its future far from Israel's borders.

Israel can implement a political plan based on the Golan Heights model. It depends on nothing more than our mentality. All that we must understand is that this is our land — not theirs. The question is whether Israel really wants peace, or if the "peace process" is just a euphemism for getting rid of the settlements that force Jewish identity on Israel's tiny "elite."

As simple and effective as this plan may be, it will most likely not be adopted. Instead, Israel's current leaders will stubbornly continue down the Oslo path of blood and terror. The sensible, Jewish solutions will all be pushed to the sidelines — because the minority ruling our country today is simply uninterested.

### **SEND MESSAGE TO SECRETARY RICE, PM OLMERT, FM LIVNI AND YOUR MEMBER OF CONGRESS - DON'T DIVIDE JERUSALEM**

It is clear from reports in recent weeks that the Olmert government, contrary to the views of the Israeli public, is planning to divide Jerusalem by conceding large parts of the city to the control of the terror-sponsoring Palestinian Authority (PA) regime of Mahmoud Abbas.

Two Olmert government ministers, Vice Premier Haim Ramon and Strategic Threats Minister, Avigdor Lieberman (Israel Beitenu), have spoken publicly of major Israeli territorial concessions in Jerusalem to the PA. These proposals contradict Kadima's platform and the explicit statements of its founder, former Prime Minister Ariel Sharon made in an April 2005 meeting with American Jewish leaders. "No serious steps have been taken by [Mahmoud Abbas], and we can't get to the Road Map plan until the PA fully implements their

obligations ... Jerusalem will never be divided and Israel will not negotiate on Jerusalem.

Dividing Jerusalem by the Olmert government has foreshadowed even the far left-wing, former Meretz representative on the Jerusalem City Council, Meir Margalit, to warn that handing over eastern Jerusalem to the control of the PA, coupled with an end to Israeli payments and transfers to its Arab residents, would turn Jerusalem into another Gaza.

It is vital that people call, email or fax Secretary of State Rice, Prime Minister Olmert, Foreign Minister Livni and your Member of Congress. Urge them not to approve any Israeli concessions under prevailing conditions and to rule out any concessions that divide the city and tear out the historical heart of Judaism from the Jewish people.

### **AUTHORS OF NATIONAL INTELLIGENCE'S ESTIMATE (NIE) ON IRAN NOW DOWNPLAY IT!**

The contested US intelligence conclusion that Iran stopped work on its nuclear weapons program in 2003 is now being downplayed by the same officials who wrote the original much-publicized report in November.

"Why would the Iranians be willing to pay the international tariff they appear to be willing to pay for what they are doing now, if they did not have at a minimum, a desire to keep the option open to develop a nuclear weapon and perhaps even more?" CIA Director Michael V. Hayden said March 30.

The four-star Air Force general said it was "hard for me to explain" the intelligence community's conclusion that Iran halted its nuclear weapons program in 2003 and probably had not restarted it as of the middle of last year. In addition, his boss, Director of National Intelligence Michael McConnell, said the report was so quickly declassified and poorly focused that it confused people. "If I had it to do over again, I would be very specific in how I described what was canceled and what continued," Mr. McConnell told a Senate panel of his community's National Intelligence Estimate (NIE) on Iran.

### **WHAT IS HAPPENING TO FRENCH JEWS?**
